

- 1. This year, the submissions for each event will be sent out to the judges as distinct **google sheet links**. Each judge should review ALL of the submissions in the event google sheet before coming to a final decision.
- 2. Before reviewing any of the submissions, for each event, please review the judging guidelines written on the criteria sheet, which can be found <u>HERE</u>. While each judge is expected to score independently, for uniformity please use the same criteria.
- After reviewing all of the submissions, each judge should complete <u>THE FINAL RESULT google form</u>, which will be sent to each judge per event. This form will ask the judge who he/she thinks should be ranked FIRST, SECOND, THIRD, FOURTH, and FIFTH. Please only submit this form, other materials used in the decision need not be submitted.
- 4. Three to Five prizes may be awarded depending on the number of contestants, level of performance, etc. As far as possible, please avoid ties. If a tie cannot be avoided, please indicate the tie on the Final Result form. Competition Directors will take this into consideration in deciding the number of awards to make for each event
- 5. The judges are solely responsible for selecting the rankings.



- 2. Judges will be able to access the links of each submission as noted below --




- 3. Once these links are clicked, judges will be taken to the submission of the respective participant submission
